Dr. Nicholas Caro, a prominent Chicago area ophthalmologist (St. George Eye Center, 4145 W. Peterson Ave., Chicago, IL 60646) (<http://www.eyelaser-center.com/>) is schedule to appear at a pre-trial hearing on 9/19 (5555 W. Grand Ave., Chicago, IL, 60639; Branch 50) to face a pre-trial hearing - I believe - for a charge of theft of \$64,000 from Elegance Anti-Aging, Inc.

Note: What makes this interesting is that, I am told what normally happens in Chicago on a financial crimes case is the detective does an investigation and, if he and his superiors feel a crime has taken place, they get an indictment, proceed to trial and let the court decide the matter.

The detective (Det. Banas) tried to get an indictment but ran into difficulties as this case is being sidetracked because numerous officials in the City of Chicago have been making phone calls and writing letters to "impede" matters, trying to prevent this case from reaching a trial!
